

CNM QUALITY/PROCESS IMPROVEMENT 2023 PROJECT AWARD GUIDELINES
Share your experience with a Quality Process Improvement Project!
Submit by December 9, 2022

Three top-scoring poster recipients will receive complimentary registration for the 2023 Symposium and a \$500.00 stipend to attend the 2023 Symposium.

We will be “displaying” all submitted posters that meet the QPI criteria (via the event app).

Symposium attendees will be able to “vote” on a “People’s Choice” poster recipient. The top-scoring poster will receive complimentary 2024 Symposium registration.

Expectations and Requirements:

Before you submit, be sure you understand and are able to comply with the requirements outlined below.

- Accepted posters will be required to complete and submit the following by April 1, 2023:
 - ✓ Your poster as a PDF (< 8 MB). Additional details will be provided to those accepted for inclusion in the poster session.
 - ✓ A photo of all authors and contact info for the primary person who can respond to questions regarding the poster.
 - ✓ By submitting an application (and if selected), you are agreeing to
 - Participating in a virtual/live brief presentation of your project if called upon, and
 - Allowing CNM DPG to include your poster/abstract on the CNM DPG website, Symposium app and/or in the CNM DPG newsletter.
 - ✓ As an option, submit a 2-minute video describing your project outcomes.

- During Symposium, a People’s Choice poster will be selected. The recipient receives complimentary 2024 Symposium registration.

Directions:

1. Complete the submission application form in its entirety and include the additional required components in the format requested.
2. Projects should be submitted via the [online form](#).
3. Send the CV of the primary author to CNM (cnmdpg@guidnunc.net).
4. Projects will be judged by a panel of peer CNM members. All entrants will be notified of results on or before December 19, 2022.
